1	WHEREAS, Section 3-202 of the Health – General Article of the Annotated Code of
2	Maryland authorizes each county board of health to set any fee or charge in connection with its
3	rules and regulations; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, Section 12.106 of the Howard County Code authorizes the Health
6	Department to charge fees for certain on-site sewage disposal related activities and for the
7	construction, alteration and operation of public pools and spas; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, fees for certain on-site sewage disposal related activities and rates related to
10	the construction, alteration and operation of public pools and spas were last adopted by the
11	passage of Council Resolution No. 79-2021; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, Section 12.107 of the Howard County Code authorizes the Health
14	Department to charge fees for certain food service facility activities that it regulates; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, fees for food service facility activities were last adopted by the passage of
17	Council Resolution No. 79-2021; and

19	WHEREAS, the Board of Health has not proposed changes for Fiscal Year 2023 to fees
20	for on-site sewage disposal related activities, pool and spa activities, or food service facility
21	licenses.

23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
24	Maryland this 25 day of, 2022, that it adopts the attached Septic and Pool
25	Fee Schedule and Food Service Facility Fee Schedule; and

27	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Schedules attached shall be effective July 1,
28	2022 and shall continue in effect until changed or repealed by subsequent resolution of the
29	County Council.

Technology Fee

In order to defray the cost of replacing the Environmental Health data management processing system for the Health Department, a technology surcharge is established and will be collected on all uncapped established fees. The amount of the technology surcharge is 10% of the approved fee rounded to the nearest dollar.
