## Resolution No. 1/7 -2013

Introduced by: The Chairperson at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION declaring that a total of approximately 0.841 acres of real property owned by Howard County and identified as a portion of the right-of-way of Dorsey Run Road is no longer needed for a public purpose; authorizing the County Executive to waive the advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code in order to convey the property to Coastal Sunbelt Produce; and providing that the County Executive is not bound to convey the property if he finds that the land may have a further public use and submits his finding to the County Council for its consideration.


1	WHEREAS, Howard County is the fee simple owner of certain real property known as a
2	portion of the right-of-way for Dorsey Run Road containing approximately 0.841 acres of land,
3	as shown in the attached Exhibit A, acquired by Deed dated November 29, 2005 and recorded
4	among the Land Records at Liber 9666, Folio 609 ("County Property"); and
5	
6	WHEREAS, Coastal Sunbelt Produce is a Howard County business seeking to expand
7	its operations by constructing a new warehouse and distribution facility (the "Development")
8	adjacent to the County Property; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, the County Property or a portion thereof, subject to the County's use of the
11	County Property for storm water management, will be required to accomplish the Development;
12	and

14	WHEREAS, Costal Sunbelt Produce has asked that the County Property be disposed of
15	in accordance with Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code to Coastal Sunbelt Produce; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has reviewed and approved the proposed
18	disposal of the County Property; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, Section 4.201, "Disposition of Real Property", of the Howard County Code
21	authorizes the County Council to declare that County Property, subject to the County's use of the
22	County Property for storm water management, is no longer needed for public purposes and also
23	authorizes the County Council to waive advertising and bidding requirements for an individual
24	conveyance of real property upon the request of the County Executive; and

26	WHEREAS, the County Council has received a request from the County Executive to
27	waive the advertising and bidding requirements in this instance for the conveyance of the County
28	Property to Coastal Sunbelt Produce.

30	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
31	Maryland, this day of , 2013, that a public purpose is served by

conveying the County Property comprising approximately 0.841 acres to Coastal Sunbelt Produce, as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, having received a request from the County Executive and having held a public hearing, the County Council declares that the best interest of the County will be served by authorizing the County Executive to waive the usual advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code for the conveyance of the County Property to Coastal Sunbelt Produce.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if the County Executive finds that the land may have a further public use and that the County Property should not be conveyed, he may submit his findings and recommendations to the County Council for its consideration without being bound to convey the County Property in accordance with this Resolution.
