Section 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the Howard County
Code is hereby amended as follows:

15	(1) Overlapping terms of three years; or
16	(2) Until a successor is confirmed.
17 18 19	(C) UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED IN LAW FOR A PARTICULAR BOARD OR COMMISSION, A MEMBER OF A BOARD OR COMMISSION SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF HOWARD COUNTY.
20	[[(c)]] (D) A member is not eligible for immediate reappointment to a Board or Commission if:
21	(1) The member has served eight or more consecutive years on a Board; and
22	(2) The member's term expires.
23 24	[[(d)]] (E) A vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment and for the unexpired term.
25 26	[[(e)]] (F) If County law requires a Board or Commission member to have certain qualifications, the County Executive may appoint a member of the general public after certifying that:
27	(1) A reasonable search was made to find a person who met the specific qualifications; and
28	(2) A person could not be found.
29 30	[[(f)]] (G) Board members shall receive no compensation for their services except reasonable and necessary expenses as may be provided in the budget.
31	Section 2. Be it further enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that this Act
32	shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.

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
