- 26 Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that,
- 27 to establish the stagger of terms of the initial appointees required by Section 12.2400 (f) of this
- 28 Act to the Adult-Use Cannabis Advisory Panel, at least 4 appointees shall have a term of 1 year,
- 29 at least 4 appointees shall have a term of 2 years, and at least 4 appointees shall have a term of
- 30 *3 years, as provided in the Resolutions that confirm the appointments.*

- 1 Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland,
- 2 that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.
