- f. *Responses*. Forty points maximum per year. One-half point for each response, regardless of its nature.
- g. *Military service*. A MAXIMUM OF FOUR YEARS CREDITABLE SERVICE MAY BE ACQUIRED FOR MILITARY SERVICE AS PROVIDED IN THIS ITEM. Fifty points per year shall be credited if volunteer service is interrupted by full-time extended obligatory military service [[or by a single voluntary enlistment which does not exceed four years in the armed forces of the United States]], PROVIDED THE VOLUNTEER:
  - I. IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING;
  - II. HAS AT LEAST ONE YEAR OF PRIOR VOLUNTEER SERVICE;
  - III. PROVIDES OFFICIAL MILITARY ORDERS; AND
  - IV. IS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM MILITARY SERVICE UNDER HONORABLE CONDITIONS.
  - h. *Permanent disability*. Fifty points per year shall be credited to any volunteer who is FOUND TO BE permanently AND TOTALLY disabled BY AN
