A RESOLUTION declaring that a portion of certain real property consisting of 0.376 acres of land located on Rogers Avenue and owned by Howard County, Maryland is no longer needed by the County for a public purpose; authorizing the County Executive to convey the property to Our Lady's Center, Inc., in exchange for the acquisition of 0.548 acres of adjacent property owned by Our Lady's Center; waiving the advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the County Code in connection with the property's conveyance; and providing that the County Executive is not bound to terminate the County's interest in the property if he finds that the property may have a further public use.

WHEREAS, Howard County, Maryland (hereinafter the "County") is the fee simple 1 2 owner of approximately 11.6640 acres of land known as Open Space Lot 11 on a subdivision plat titled "Oak West, Section 1 Area 1, Lots 1 Thru 11" as recorded in the Land Records of Howard 3 County, Maryland as Plat Number 7505, and also being shown as Parcel 312 on Tax Map 25, 4 acquired by deed dated February 4, 1987 recorded in Liber 1752, Folio 026 in the Land Records 5 (the "County Property"); and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, Our Lady's Center owns a parcel of land known as 3301 Rogers Avenue, Ellicott City, Maryland and shown as Parcel 165 on Tax Map 25, acquired by deed from Frank C. 9 Lancelotta, said deed dated October 15, 1982 and recorded among the Land Records in Liber 1752, 10 11 folio 26 (the "Our Lady's Center Property"); and 12 WHEREAS, approximately 0.548 acres (23,850 sq. ft.) of the Our Lady's Center Property 13 is Open Space (the "Open Space"), shown in red in the attached Exhibit A; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, Our Lady's Center seeks to exchange and convey, or "swap", the Open Space to the County in exchange for the conveyance of a portion of the County Property, containing 17 18 approximately 0.376 acres (16,400 sq. ft.) of land, used as a parking lot (the "Parking Lot"), shown in blue in the attached Exhibit A; and 19 20 WHEREAS, additionally, Our Lady's Center agreed to convey to the County various 21 22 easements (the "Easements") on Our Lady's Center Property if the proposed land swap is approved by County Council and the Easements will be used for Capital Project S-6283 to construct 23 24 improvements to the Sucker Branch Interceptor; and 25 WHEREAS, the Howard County Department of Public Works and the Department of 26 Recreation and Parks have reviewed and approved the proposed conveyance of the Parking Lot in 27 28 exchange for the Open Space; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Section 4.201, "Disposition of Real Property", of the Howard County Code authorizes the County Council of Howard County, Maryland (the "County Council") to declare 31

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that property is no longer needed for public purposes and also authorizes the County Council to waive advertising and bidding requirements for an individual conveyance of real property upon the request of the County Executive; and

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5 WHEREAS, the County Council has received a request from the County Executive to 6 waive the advertising and bidding requirements in this instance for the conveyance of the Parking 7 Lot to Our Lady's Center in exchange for the acquisition of the Open Space from Our Lady's 8 Center.

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10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County, 11 Maryland, this <u>4</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2023, that the Parking Lot as shown in blue on 12 the attached Exhibit A containing approximately 0.376 acres (16,400 sq. ft.) of land in total is no 13 longer needed by the County for public purposes.

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AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive may convey fee simple title to the Parking Lot to Our Lady's Center and, in exchange, Our Lady's Center will convey the Open Space, containing approximately 0.548 acres (23,850 sq. ft.) of land to the County as shown in red on the attached Exhibit A.

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AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, having received a request from the County Executive and having held a public hearing, the County Council declares that the best interest of the County will be served by authorizing the County Executive to waive the usual advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code for the conveyance of fee simple title to Our Lady's Center.

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AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the County Executive finds that all or a portion of the Parking Lot may have a further County public use then he is not bound to convey the fee simple interest in accordance with this resolution. The Department of Public Works has been designated coordinator for preparation of testimony relative to the conveyance of 0.376 acres of land owned by Howard County, Maryland and located on Rogers Avenue to Our Lady's Center, Inc., in exchange for the acquisition of 0.548 acres of open space property owned by Our Lady's Center by Howard County, Maryland.

The County owns a parcel of land known as Open Space Lot 11 on a subdivision plat titled "Oak West, Section 1 Area 1, Lots 1 Thru 11" as recorded in the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland (the "Land Records") as Plat Number 7505, and also being shown as Parcel 312 on Tax Map 25 and comprising 11.6640 acres, acquired by deed dated February 4, 1987 recorded in Liber 1752, Folio 026 in the Land Records (the "County Property").

Our Lady's Center owns a parcel of land known as 3301 Rogers Avenue, Ellicott City, Maryland and shown as Parcel 165 on Tax Map 25, acquired by deed from Frank C. Lancelotta, said deed dated October 15, 1982 and recorded among the Land Records in Liber 1752, folio 26 (the "Our Lady's Center Property").

Our Lady's Center seeks to exchange and convey to the County a portion Our Lady's Center land used as open space, containing approximately 23,850 sq. ft. of land, (the "Open Space") for conveyance of approximately 16,400 sq. ft. of the County Property, used as a parking lot (the "Parking Lot") as shown on the attached Exhibit "A". In addition, Our Lady's Center agrees to convey to the County various easements (the "Easements") on Our Lady's Center Property if the proposed land swap is approved by County Council. The Easements will be used for Capital Project S-6283 to construct improvements to the Sucker Branch Interceptor.

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The Department of Public Works has reviewed and approves the proposed conveyance of the County Property in exchange for the Our Lady's Center Property.

The fiscal impact would be the County's acquisition of the larger Open Space land in exchange for the smaller Parking Lot.
