1	WHEREAS, all human life is precious, and the targeting of civilians, no matter their
2	faith or ethnicity, is a violation of international humanitarian law; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, between October 7, 2023 and January 25, 2024, armed violence has
5	claimed the lives of over 25,000 Palestinians and over 1,400 Israelis, including Americans, and
6	wounded thousands more; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, Maryland's United States Congressmen Kweisi Mfume and Jamie Raskin,
9	and most recently Senator Chris Van Hollen, have called for an immediate cease-fire;

11	WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of lives are at imminent risk if a cease-fire is not
12	achieved and humanitarian aid is not delivered without further delay.

14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
15	Maryland this day of, 2024 that Howard County Council demands that
16	the Biden administration immediately call for and facilitate a cease-fire in Gaza; and

18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Howard County Council calls upon the Biden
19	administration to promptly send and facilitate the entry of humanitarian assistance into Gaza; and

21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to United States
22	Congressmen Dutch Ruppersburger, John Sarbanes, Glenn Ivey, Steny Hoyer, David Trone,
23	Kweisi Mfume and Jamie Raskin; United States Senators Ben Cardin and Chris Van Hollen; and
24	to President Joe Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris, urging them to take immediate action
25	to use their position and influence to end this humanitarian crisis.
