1 **Section 1. Be It Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the Howard
2 County Code is amended as follows:

11 **SECTION 20.103. ADVANCE PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX.**

12 (A) *PAYMENT AUTHORIZED.* A PROPERTY OWNER MAY MAKE ADVANCE PAYMENT OF COUNTY REAL
13 PROPERTY TAX IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10-205 OF THE TAX-PROPERTY
14 ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

15 (B) *CALCULATION OF PAYMENT.* THE ADVANCE PAYMENT IS CALCULATED BY APPLYING THE
16 CURRENT COUNTY PROPERTY TAX RATE TO THE ASSESSMENT OF THE PROPERTY OWNER'S REAL
17 PROPERTY FOR THE PRIOR YEAR.

18 (C) *BILLING.* IF THE ADVANCE PAYMENT IS LESS THAN THE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY TAX AS
19 FINALLY DETERMINED, THE COUNTY SHALL SEND A BILL TO THE PROPERTY OWNER FOR THE
20 DIFFERENCE.

21 (D) *OVERPAYMENT.* IF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX PAID UNDER THIS SECTION IS MORE THAN THE
22 REAL PROPERTY TAX FINALLY DETERMINED, THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE SHALL SEND A REFUND TO
23 THE PROPERTY OWNER.

25 **Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland,
26 *that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*
