Youth members shall serve staggered terms of two years. 11 (2) Vacancies on the Board shall be filled in the same manner as the original 12 appointment or for the unexpired term. 13 (3) At the end of the term a member of the Board, the member continues to serve 14 15 until a successor is appointed. (4) A member of the Board who is appointed to complete an unexpired term serves 16 only for the rest of that term, unless the member is reappointed. 17 (f) *Removal from Office:* In accordance with the provisions of section 903 of the Howard 18 County Charter, a member of the Board may be removed for incompetence, misconduct, 19 20 or failure to perform the duties of the position. 21 (g) *Officers of the Board*: 22 (1) The Board shall elect Officers from among its members, to serve two-year terms as Officers. 23 24 (2) The Officers shall consist of a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, and three Second Vice-Chairpersons. 25 26 (3) A member may not be elected to the same office for more than two consecutive 27 terms. 28 Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, 29 30 Maryland, that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.
