Council Bill No. 20-2025

Introduced: March 3, 2025 Auditor: Diane Zagorski-Kelly

Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined because we are unable to estimate the amount of excess surplus funds available to the County. According to the County's Budget Administrator (the Administrator), estimated excess surplus funds from Fiscal Year 2025 cannot be forecasted at this time due to rapid economic changes at the federal level.

The Administrator advised that excess surplus funds for FY 2025 will be available when the FY 2025 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report is prepared following the close of the current fiscal year. Additionally, with the FY 2026 budget currently under development, anticipated excess surplus funds allocations for FY 2026 cannot be determined at this time.

Purpose:

Council Bill 20-2025 seeks to allow excess surplus County funds to be spent on deferred capital projects for Howard County Public School System (HCPSS).

Other Comments:

According to the Administrator, the FY 2025 approved budget's surplus funds from prior fiscal year's surplus funds were allocated as follows:

- \$15 million for HCPSS systemic renovations for deferred maintenance
- \$5 million for HCPSS one-time costs in its FY 2025 operating budget
