SHORT TITLE: Lodging Establishments – Prohibition on Hourly Room Rentals

AN ACT amending the Howard County Code to prohibit an innkeeper or employee of a lodging establishment in Howard County from providing or offering to provide certain rooms in a lodging establishment for less than a certain period of time; and generally related to lodging establishments.

16 **SEC. 14.000. –PURPOSE.**

17 (A) PURPOSE. IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE, THE PURPOSE
18 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS PREVENTING POSSIBLE HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND OTHER CRIMINAL
19 ACTIVITY WHILE ENSURING MINIMAL DISRUPTION TO LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS.

21 (B) DEFINITIONS.

22 IN GENERAL. IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:

23 (1) *INNKEEPER* MEANS THE OWNER, OPERATOR, MANAGER, OR KEEPER OF A LODGING
24 ESTABLISHMENT, OR THE AGENT OF AN OWNER, OPERATOR, MANAGER, OR KEEPER OF A
25 LODGING ESTABLISHMENT.

26 (2) *LODGING ESTABLISHMENT* MEANS AN INN, HOTEL, MOTEL, OR OTHER ESTABLISHMENT THAT HAS
27 AT LEAST FOUR ROOMS AVAILABLE FOR A FEE TO TRANSIENT GUESTS FOR LODGING OR SLEEPING
28 PURPOSES.

1 (C) – LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS, HOURLY ROOM RATES, PROHIBITION.

2 (1) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE RENTAL OF A MEETING, DINING, OR BANQUET ROOM IN A
3 LODGING ESTABLISHMENT.

4 (2) AN INNKEEPER OR EMPLOYEE OF A LODGING ESTABLISHMENT MAY NOT FOR A FEE PROVIDE OR
5 OFFER TO PROVIDE A ROOM IN THE LODGING ESTABLISHMENT FOR AN HOURLY PERIOD.

6 (D). – ENFORCEMENT.

7 THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS, LICENSES AND PERMITS MAY ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
8 SUBTITLE WITH CIVIL PENALTIES PURSUANT TO TITLE 24, “CIVIL PENALTIES” OF THE HOWARD
9 COUNTY CODE. VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION IS A CLASS A OFFENSE AND EACH INSTANCE A
10 VIOLATION OCCURS IS A SPERATE OFFENSE.

12 ***Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County,***
13 ***Maryland, that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.***
