Title: A RESOLUTION approving a schedule of fines and penalties for violations of and administrative costs related to the enforcement of Howard County's parking laws, specifically increasing fines for parking citations for commercial motor vehicle parking in residential areas violations; allowing the Department of Police to embark on a public education campaign about the increased fines for commercial motor vehicles parking on residential areas violations; and generally relating to increased fines for commercial motor vehicles parking in residential area violations.

1 **WHEREAS**, Section 21.202 of the Howard County Code requires that the County
2 Council adopt a schedule of fines for violations of county parking laws; and
3

4 **WHEREAS**, Section 21.232 of the Howard County Code prohibits an individual from
5 parking a commercial motor vehicle for more than six continuous hours on any highway in the
6 residential areas of Howard County; and
7

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 21.101(g) of the Howard County Code defines a “Commercial
9 motor vehicle” as a motor vehicle registered with the motor vehicle administration under one of
10 the following classes; Class C (funeral and ambulance) vehicles; Class E (truck) vehicles which
11 includes, truck trailer combinations, dump truck registrations, tow trucks, or vehicles that display
12 permanently affixed commercial advertising or Maryland Home Improvement Commission
13 (“MHIC”) license number on the exterior body; Class F (tractor) vehicles; Class G (trailer)
14 vehicles; Class H (school) vehicles; or Class P (passenger bus) vehicles; or any motor vehicle
15 used in furtherance of any commercial purpose for the carrying of material, which includes but is
16 not limited to freight, merchandise, supplies, equipment, or debris.; and

18 **WHEREAS**, these rates were last adopted by the passage of Council Resolution No. 99-
19 2025 for Fiscal Year 2026; and

21 **WHEREAS**, The Howard County Police Department intends to conduct an education
22 and outreach campaign before and during the implementation of this Resolution.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,
25 Maryland this _____ day of _____, 2025, that it adopts the attached schedules of fines
26 and penalties; and

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
29 that this Resolution is contingent upon the enactment of Council Bill No._____, and that if
30 Council Bill No. ____ fails, then this Resolution shall have no force and effect of law; and

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
2 that this Resolution shall become effective upon the effective date of Council Bill No. ____; and

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
5 that fines for “parking commercial motor vehicles in residential areas” is amended as follows and
6 shall continue to be in effect until changed or repealed by a subsequent resolution of the County
7 Council.

**SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF
HOWARD COUNTY PARKING LAWS**

These fines are established in accordance with Section 21.202 of the Howard County Code, which requires the County Council to adopt a schedule of fines for violations of county parking laws.
