2	the Howard County Charter is amended as follows:
3	By amending: Article II. The Legislative Branch.
4	Section 209. Legislative procedure.
5	Subsection 209(h). Failure of bills.

11	(h) Failure of bills. Any bill not passed within sixty-five calendar days after its
12	introduction shall fail, unless, by affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members,
13	the Council shall extend the deadline for another thirty days. The COUNCIL MAY
14	APPROVE A MAXIMUM OF TWO SUCH EXTENSIONS FOR EACH BILL.

16	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
17	County, Maryland, that at the next general election to be held in Maryland, the proposed
18	amendment to the Howard County Charter shall be submitted to the voters of Howard
19	County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with the provisions of the Article $X$
20	of the Howard County Charter and Article XIA of the Maryland Constitution, and if
21	adopted by the majority of the voters, shall stand adopted from and after the $30^{th}$ day
22	following the general election;

24	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
25	County, Maryland, that this Resolution, having been approved by two-thirds of the
26	members of the Howard County Council, stands adopted this25 <sup>73</sup> day of
27	, 2014 in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.
