On page 87 of the Gateway Master Plan draft, attached to Amendment 4, in line 2, strike 1 2 "Redevelopment should" and insert the following: "Given the presence of environmental contamination, parcels designated as Brownfields must 3 4 undergo current federally required remediation before any residential redevelopment occurs. As long as contamination persists, residential uses are prohibited. Supporting industrial or low-5 6 density industrial uses are more appropriate for those sites. Supporting industrial uses should be properly shielded by a structure, screened or set back from neighboring uses. After remediation, 7 redevelopment could". 8 9 10 On page 87 of the Gateway Master Plan draft, attached to Amendment 4, strike lines 4-7 in their 11 entirety. 12 On page 87 of the Gateway Master Plan draft, attached to Amendment 4, in line 9, strike 13 beginning with The" through "to", and substitute the following: "After the former landfill site 14 (PAR A) has been remediated to current Federal environmental standards, the site could".
