A RESOLUTION to amend the Howard County Charter to increase the number of members of the Howard County Board of Appeals from five to seven members; update the political party affiliation distribution of Board members; and submitting this amendment to the voters of Howard County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter and Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution.

1	WHEREAS, the Howard County Charter establishes a Board of Appeals to hear and
2	decide appeals, variances, special exceptions, and other matters as provided by law; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, the Board of Appeals performs a quasi-judicial function that is essential to
5	ensuring due process, fair hearings, and consistent application of County land use and zoning
6	laws; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the current composition of the Board of Appeals consists of five members,
9	which may limit scheduling flexibility and the timely resolution of cases when recusals,
10	vacancies, or absences occur; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, expanding the Board of Appeals to seven members would enhance the
13	Board's capacity to hear cases efficiently, reduce delays, and ensure the consistent participation
14	of a full panel; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, increasing the number of Board of Appeals members would support
17	continuity of operations and provide additional expertise and perspective in the review of appeals
18	and applications; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, the Howard County Council finds that amending the Charter to increase the
21	membership of the Board of Appeals from five to seven members serves the public interest;
22	
23	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
24	Maryland thisday of, 2026 that Section 501(a) of the Howard County
25	Charter is amended to read as follows:

27	Article V. – Board of Appeals
28	Section 501. – The County Board of Appeals
29	Section 501. – The County Board of Appeals
30	(a) Appointment; term; compensation. The County Board of Appeals shall consist of [[five]]
31	SEVEN registered voters and residents of the County appointed by the Council. Appointees shall

1	serve overlapping terms of five years from the first day of January of the year of their
2	appointments, or until their successors are appointed. Vacancies, except those at the expiration of
3	a term, shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment and for the unexpired term.
4	No member shall be reappointed after having served eight consecutive years immediately prior
5	to reappointment. No more than [[three]] FOUR members shall be registered with the same
6	political party. The members of the Board shall be paid at the rate of Twelve Hundred Dollars
7	(\$1,200.00) per year unless such compensation be changed as provided in Section 501(f) of this
8	article. Members of the Board shall receive reasonable and necessary expenses as may be
9	provided in the budget.

11	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
12	Maryland, that at the next General Election to be held in Maryland, the proposed amendment to
13	the Howard County Charter shall be submitted to the voters of Howard County for their adoption
14	or rejection in accordance with the provisions of the Article X of the Howard County Charter and
15	Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution, and if adopted by the majority of the voters, shall
16	stand adopted from and after the 30th day following the general election.

18	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
19	Maryland, that this Resolution, having been approved by two-thirds of the members of the
20	Howard County Council, stands adopted this day of, 2026 in accordance
21	with provisions of Article X of the Howard County Charter.
