1	BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that
2	Section 603 "Submission and contents of the County budget" subsection (a) "Contents of
3	current expense budget", of Article VI, "Budgetary and Fiscal Procedures", of the
4	Howard County Charter, be, and is hereby amended to read as follows:
5	
6	Section 603. Submission and contents of the County budget.
7	(a) Contents of the current expense budget. The proposed current expense budget shall
8	contain not less than the following information:
9	(1) A statement of all revenue estimated to be received by the County during the
10	ensuing fiscal year, classified so as to show the receipts by funds and sources of
11	income;
12	(2) A statement of debt service requirements for the ensuing fiscal year;
13	(3) A statement of the estimated cash surplus, if any, available for expenditure
14	during the ensuing fiscal year, and any estimated deficit in any fund required to be
15	made up in the ensuing fiscal year;
16	(4) An estimate of the several amounts, including any arbitrator's award made
17	pursuant to section 217, which the executive deems necessary for conducting the
18	business of the County to be financed from and not to exceed estimated revenue for
19	the ensuing fiscal year;
20	(5) A statement of the bonded and other indebtedness of the County government
21	and its agencies, including self-liquidating and special taxing district debt;
22	(6) A statement of the proposed contingency reserves FOR THE GENERAL FUND AND
23	EACH OTHER FUND which shall not exceed three per centum of [[the general fund and
24	of any other]] EACH fund;
25	(6) [[A]] EXCLUDING ANY FUND BALANCE, A statement of the proposed contingency
26	reserves for the general fund and each special fund, including any fund
27	WHICH BY LAW HAS A DEDICATED REVENUE SOURCE, which CONTINGENCY RESERVES
28	shall not exceed three per centum of [[the general fund and of any other]] EACH
29	<u>SUCH fund.</u>
30	(7) A comparative statement of the receipts and expenditures for the last
31	completed fiscal year, a comparative statement of authorized expenditures and

1	revenues and estimated expenditures and revenues for the currently ending fiscal		
2	year, and the expenditures recommended by the Executive for the ensuing fisca		
3	year for each program or project which shall be classified by agency, character an		
4	object; and		
5	(8) Any other material which the Executive may deem advisable or the Council		
6	may require.

8	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard		
9	County, Maryland, that at the next general election to be held in Maryland, the proposed		
10	amendment to the Howard County Charter shall be submitted to the voters of Howard		
11	County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with the provisions of the Article X		
12	of the Howard County Charter and Article XIA of the Maryland Constitution, and if		
13	adopted by the majority of the voters, shall stand adopted from and after the 30^{th} day		
14	following the general election;

16	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard		
17	County, Maryland, that this Resolution, having been approved by two-thirds of the		
18	members of the Howard County Council, stands adopted this day of		
19	, 2012 in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.
