The Department of Public Works requests the transfer of \$9,975.00 from the Grant Contingency Fund for an Earth Tub Composter purchased by the Bureau of Environmental Services. The Earth Tub will be used by the Department of Corrections at the Detention Center for food scrap composting. The Department was able to acquire the Earth Tub with operating funds but would now like to take advantage of certain grant funds that are available. This grant funding was awarded by the Environmental Protection Agency Region III to the Bureau of Environmental Services under Assistance Agreement X1-963038-01-0. A new grant account within the Environmental Services Fund will need to be created to receive the grant funds. There is no fiscal impact associated with this supplemental request as the appropriations to be transferred are not encumbered and are available for transfer.
