WHEREAS, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, the County has been awarded grant funds from the Maryland Department of the Environment to assist in improving enhanced nutrient removal performance levels; and

WHEREAS, one grant is in the amount of \$100,000 and another grant is in the amount of \$300,000, for a total of \$400,000; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE,

***Section 1. Be It Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the following supplementary appropriation of funds is authorized and approved for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, as indicated below:*


