Due to recent legislation, the State's Attorney's Office needs to be present at initial bond hearings. This requires an Assistant State's Attorney to be "on-call" every day. During the work week, this responsibility is handled by an assigned attorney at no additional cost to the County. However, on Saturday, Sundays and Holidays, it is necessary for an Assistant State's Attorney to be available for the Police and District Court Commissioner.

For the first four months of FY15, the additional cost to the County has been \$6,200.00. We anticipate the through June 30, 2015; the total expenditure will be approximately \$19,000.00.
