Amendment No. 1 to Amendment 1

(This amendment clarifies the need for the Committee and the kinds of programs elsewhere that the Committee should review.)

1 On page 1, strike lines 2, 3, and 4 and substitute:

2 *“Also on page 1, strike lines 19 through 24 and substitute “WHEREAS, in the absence of*
3 *crisis, it is prudent to consider opportunities to focus on strengthening relationships between*
4 *police, community leaders, and the broader community to improve public safety and mutual*
5 *respect, including enhancements to:*

6 *(1) police presence in the community;*

7 *(2) equipment and resources available to law enforcement officials, including new uses for*
8 *technology such as body cameras;*

9 *(3) community awareness of the daily risks faced by police in carrying out their duties; and*

10 *(4) research and adoption of best practices in law enforcement; and”.*

11 Also on page 1, strike line 7 in its entirety.

12 Also on page 1, strike lines 8 through 13 and substitute:

13 *“Also on page 2, in line 10, strike “in the U.S.” and in line 11 after “County” insert “,*
14 *including community outreach programs which offer training and simulation activities to*
15 *enhance public understanding of the duties and responsibilities of the police as well as the*
16 *risks and challenges they face”.*

17 Also on page 1, before line 14 insert:

18 *“On page 2, at line 20, insert: “AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council*
19 *of Howard County that as the Committee on Community Policing accomplishes the work*
20 *outlined in this Resolution it should consider, but not be limited to, all the factors listed in the*
21 *preamble of this Resolution.””*
