1	WHEREAS, Section 4-102 of the Tax-General Article of the Annotated Code of
2	Maryland authorizes counties to levy, by resolution, a tax on the gross receipts derived from
3	admissions and amusement charges; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, On May 22, 2008, the Howard County Council adopted Resolution No.
6	56-2008, which set the admissions and amusements tax rate for Fiscal Year 2009; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the Howard County Council believes that certain hot air balloon activities
9	are regulated by federal law and may be exempt from local admissions and amusements taxes;
10	and
11	
12	WHEREAS, the Howard County Council wishes to support hot air balloon enterprises.
13	
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
15	Maryland this day of, 2009, that the hot air balloon enterprises are
16	exempt from the admissions and amusements tax.

18	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
19	Maryland that the following be added to Resolution No.56-2008 on page 2 after line 18:

21	"(4) Gross receipts derived from non-tethered hot air balloon activities that are regulated
22	by the federal government;"

24	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,
25	Maryland, that the Council Administrator shall send a copy of this Resolution to the Comptroller
26	of the Treasury of the State of Maryland.
