2	Maryland requires each county governing body to adopt a Master Plan for Water and Sewerage
3	and to review the plan every 3 years; and

5	WHEREAS, the County Council and County Executive approved a comprehensive
6	revision of the Master Plan for Water and Sewerage by adoption of Council Resolution 77-2008
7	on October 6, 2008; and

9	WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works prepares these semiannual updates to keep
10	the Master Plan current, this being the first update since the comprehensive revision was
11	adopted; and

13	WHEREAS, in accordance with the Master Plan and State law, the Department of Public
14	Works has prepared, and submitted for review and certification, the first semiannual update for
15	2009.
