1	WHEREAS, the County Council of Howard County, Maryland recognizes that
2	there is a significant need for quality housing units in Howard County for families of low or
3	moderate income; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, HCH Partners II, LLC, a Maryland limited liability corporation,
6	proposes to develop and operate a rental housing development comprised of approximately
7	269 units, now known as Guilford Gardens and located on 7333 Oakland Mills Road in
8	Columbia, Maryland (the "Project"), a portion of which will assist families of low or
9	limited income as required by applicable law or regulation; and

11	WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development,
12	either directly or through the Community Development Administration, may provide some
13	or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making
14	the project economically feasible; and

16	WHEREAS, Section 4-1207(a) of the Housing and Community Development
17	Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Sections 5.05.05.18(11) through (13) of the
18	Code of Maryland Regulations require approval of the Project and the Project Financing by
19	the County Executive and the County Council; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the County Executive of Howard County has approved the proposed
22	Project and Project Financing and recommends their approval by the County Council.

24	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
25	County, Maryland this <u>day</u> of <u>May</u> , 2009, that it endorses the Project and
26	approves the Project Financing in the form of (i) a Partnership Rental Housing Program
27	loan in the approximate amount of \$3,625,000; (ii) a Low Income Housing Tax Credit
28	reservation in the approximate amount of \$1,236,635; and (iii) a HUD-insured loan in the
29	approximate amount of \$25,900,000.
