Amendment No. 8

(This amendment expands the financial hardship program.)

1 On page 17, in line 21, strike “RESIDENTIAL”.

2 Also on page 17, in line 29, strike “INDIVIDUAL” and substitute “APPLICANT”.

3 On page 18, strike lines 1 through 8 in their entirety and substitute:

4 “(I) THE APPLICANT IS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

5 1. OWNS RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY FOR WHICH THE WATERSHED PROTECTION AND
6 RESTORATION FEE APPLIES;

7 2. HAS AN INCOME OF 250 PERCENT OR LESS OF THE POVERTY LEVEL, AS ESTABLISHED
8 BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, AND ADJUSTED FOR FAMILY SIZE;
9 AND

10 3. ON JULY 1 OF THE YEAR IN WHICH APPLICATION IS MADE, RESIDES IN THE PROPERTY
11 WHICH IS SUBJECT TO THE WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION FEE; OR

13 (II) THE APPLICANT OWNS NONRESIDENTIAL PROPERTY THAT MEETS THE CRITERIA THAT THE
14 COUNTY EXECUTIVE SETS BY EXECUTIVE ORDER DEMONSTRATING THAT A REDUCTION IN THE
15 WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION FEE IS NECESSARY TO AVOID SUBSTANTIAL
16 FINANCIAL HARDSHIP.”
