Amendment No. 2

(This amendment would require certain notifications that hunting may occur.)

On page 4, after line 28, insert:

“(D) ANNUALLY, AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE ANY GUN IS DISCHARGED ON PROPERTY COVERED
BY THIS SECTION, THE PROPERTY OWNER SHALL:

(1) SEND WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE THAT STATES WHEN HUNTING WILL
OCCUR;

(2) NOTIFY BY FIRST CLASS MAIL EACH RESIDENT OF ABUTTING PROPERTIES THAT
STATES WHEN HUNTING MAY OCCUR; AND

. (3) POST, AT THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO THE PROPERTY, A SIGN THAT:

(I) INDICATES THE RANGE OF DATES WHEN HUNTING MAY OCCUR; AND

(II) IS OF THE SAME SIZE AND STYLE AS THE SIGNS THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF
RECREATION AND PARKS POSTS FOR MANAGED HUNTS.”

Also on page 4, In line 29, strike “D” and substitute “(E)”.
