1 *Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that*  
2 *Subsection 1 "Criteria for Removal of Parcel(s)" and Subsection (5) "Administrative*  
3 *Procedures Upon Enactment of Ordinance" of Section 18.125 "Removal of parcel(s) from*  
4 *Metropolitan District" of Subtitle 1 "Public Utilities" of Title 18 "Public Works" of the*  
5 *Howard County Code are amended to read as follows :*

7 **Title 18. Public Works.**

8 **Subtitle 1. Public Utilities.**

9 **Sec. 18.125. Removal of parcel(s) from Metropolitan District.**

10 (1) Criteria for Removal of Parcel(s): Parcel(s) of land which meet all of the following  
11 criteria may be removed from the metropolitan district:

12 (a) The parcel is contiguous to non-Metropolitan District property; and

13 (b) The parcel is contiguous to the perimeter of the Metropolitan District; and

14 (c) There is no water or sewer connection to the parcel, or allocation of water or  
15 sewage treatment units; and

16 (d) (i) In accordance with subtitle 5, "Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation  
17 Foundation" of title 2 of the Agricultural Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland or  
18 subtitle 5, "Agricultural Land Preservation," of title 15 of the Howard County Code:

19 [[[i)]]] 1. The parcel is all or part of an agricultural land preservation  
20 district; and

21 [[[ii)]]] 2. The owner has made written application to sell an agricultural  
22 land preservation easement to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation  
23 Foundation or to sell development rights to Howard County ; OR

24 (ii) THE PARCEL IS SUBJECT TO A PERMANENT CONSERVATION, PRESERVATION, OR  
25 SIMILAR EASEMENT THAT IS HELD BY A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT, THE MARYLAND  
26 ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST, OR A LOCAL LAND TRUST THAT QUALIFIES UNDER § 170(h)(3) OF  
27 THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

1 (5) Administrative Procedures Upon Enactment of Ordinance: Whenever settlement has  
2 occurred for the acquisition of an [[agricultural land preservation]] easement UNDER THIS  
3 SECTION, for the acquisition of development rights or for the fee simple acquisition for  
4 agricultural preservation:

5 (a) The owner shall notify the director of public works of the date that settlement  
6 has occurred.

7 (b) The director of public works shall notify the county council and the office of  
8 planning and zoning of the date that settlement has occurred.

9 (c) The director of public works shall notify the director of finance that the  
10 parcel(s) have been removed from the Metropolitan District and are no longer subject to  
11 provisions of Howard County law affecting the financing of improvements to the  
12 Metropolitan District.

13 (d) The director of public works shall revise all required copies of the  
14 Metropolitan District plat to reflect removal of the parcel(s) from the Metropolitan District.

16 ***Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County,***  
17 ***Maryland, that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.***
