Amendment No. 5

(This amendment would:

- remove a specific reference to the EDA;
- recognize that existing businesses need support;
- address concerns of the Howard County Commission on Disability Issues;
- substitute a generic reference of an evolving technology for a specific reference;
- clarify that public / private partnerships might include non-profits;
- recognize that Snowden River Parkway has a variety of sections).

In PlanHoward 2030, as attached to the Bill, make the following changes:

On pages 53 and 166, in Policy 5.1, strike “**Implement key actions from EDA’s 2011 Strategic Plan**” and substitute “**Identify, develop, implement and refine a comprehensive program**”.

On pages 54 and 166, in Policy 5.1, add a new Implementing Action:
“**h. Existing Businesses. Continue to support and address the needs of existing businesses.**”.

For new Implementing Action 5.1h, note in Appendix A as “On Going”.

On pages 54 and 166, in Policy 5.2, in “Implementing Actions” section, in letter “d”, strike the last sentence and substitute, “**Increase participation by minorities, women, and individuals with disabilities.**”.

On pages 54 and 167, under Policy 5.3, in implementing action b, strike ““smart grid”” and substitute “**developing**”.

On page 57 and 167, under “POLICY 5.5”, in implementing action (e), strike “(i.e., County / EDA as developer)” and substitute: “, including opportunities for non-profits”.

On pages 58 and 168, in Policy 5.6, add a new Implementing Action:
“c. **Differentiate when planning. Distinguish among the sections along Snowden River Parkway that exhibit different characteristics and merit different treatment.**” For new Implementing Action 5.6c, note in Appendix A as “On Going”.
