**Amended Amendment No. 12 \_**

*(The amendment removes reference to specific critical lane volume requirements and clarifies that any change in critical lane volume will be established in subsequent adequate public facilities legislation.)*

1 In the attachment, on page 20, strike the first sentence in the section titled “New Level of  
2 Service Standard” and substitute:

4 “The level of service for all County-controlled intersections serving Downtown  
5 Columbia should reflect its more urban, pedestrian oriented character. Therefore, this  
6 plan anticipates a higher critical lane volume (CLV) than exists in the rest of the County.  
7 The appropriate level of service standard (~~CLV~~) will be established as part of the  
8 Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance legislation.”.

10 Also on page 20, after the last paragraph in the same section, insert:

11  
12 “To consider the many recommended changes to the Adequate Public Facilities  
13 Ordinance, this Plan envisions the filing of an amendment to the Act within 120 days.”.
