The Governor's Office on Crime Control and Prevention (GOCCP) has awarded the "Warrant/Fugitive Section-VOWR Grant" to the Police Department. The total amount of the award is \$103,102. There is no match required. The grant award period is July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010. This grant funding is a pass-through from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act via the US Department of Justice (BJAG CFDA# 16.803).

The "Warrant/Fugitive Section-VOWR Grant" funds officer overtime for the purpose of servicing arrest warrants for violent crimes. Additionally, the award provides for the service of any arrest warrant issued to violent offenders who are under the supervision of the Department of Parole and Probation. This program addresses the growing backlog of outstanding violent offender arrest warrants in Howard County.
