1       **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and  
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the  
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

6       **WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded grant funding in the amount  
7 of \$18,294 from the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention; and

9       **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used to purchase Mobile Data Computers and  
10 the computer's software and to pay the installation costs; and

12       **WHEREAS**, the Mobile Data Computers will be used to keep domestic violence  
13 documents, electronic traffic citations and online incident reports and to link up with  
14 State databases; and

16       **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
17 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
