1 **WHEREAS**, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the
2 State of Maryland has notified the County that the County will receive grant funding in
3 the amount of \$3,000,000 for road resurfacing projects; and

5 **WHEREAS**, capital project H-2008, Road Resurfacing Program, currently does
6 not contain spending authority for grant funds; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has requested a transfer of appropriations in
9 the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for Fiscal 2009 to transfer \$3,000,000
10 in grant funding from capital project C-0214, Category Contingency Fund, to capital project
11 H-2008, Road Resurfacing Program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Section 609(b) of the Howard County Charter authorizes and
14 empowers the Howard County Council to make such transfers; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
17 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.

19 *Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that,*
20 *subject to the provisions of Maryland law, the Howard County Charter, and the Howard*
21 *County Code relating to the budgetary and fiscal procedures, the amount hereafter*
22 *specified is hereby approved, appropriated, and authorized to be disbursed for the*
23 *general County purposes specified and in sums itemized for the fiscal year beginning July*
24 *1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009, as hereinafter indicated:*
