**WHEREAS, grant funding will be used to pay costs associated with the Community Services Support Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Community Services Support Program had previously been called the Community Service Program and was administered by the Sheriff's Office; and**

**WHEREAS, the Community Services Support Program will be administered by the Department of Corrections; and**

**WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.**

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

***Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the following supplementary appropriation of funds is authorized and approved for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010, as indicated below:***
