1       **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and  
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the  
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

6       **WHEREAS**, as part of the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008, the  
7 State of Maryland, Department of Housing and Community Development has awarded  
8 the Howard County Department of Housing and Community Development a grant of  
9 \$750,000 from its Neighborhood Conservation Initiative (NCI) Program; and

11       **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used to acquire and rehabilitate vacant,  
12 foreclosed houses for resale to qualified homebuyers as part of the Neighborhood  
13 Conservation Initiative (NCI) Project; and

15       **WHEREAS**, the grant requires matching funds in the amount of \$572,466 which  
16 have already been appropriated to the Howard County Department of Housing and  
17 Community Development's Fiscal Year 2010 budget; and

19       **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
20 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
