1 **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;
4 and

6 **WHEREAS**, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the
7 Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation (DLLR) has allocated further
8 grant funding for the Maryland Business Works (MBW) program; and

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10 **WHEREAS**, as of the beginning of Fiscal Year 2010, the Office of Workforce
11 Development had received \$28,000 in grant funding for the MBW program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Office of Workforce Development has requested additional
14 grant funding in the amount \$125,000 for a total of \$153,000 in funds to be received from
15 DLLR; and

16
17 **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used to reimburse eligible businesses for up to
18 half the training costs for incumbent workers; and

19
20 **WHEREAS**, the budget for Fiscal Year 2010 contains \$45,000 in spending
21 authority for the MBW program and, therefore, the Office of Workforce Development
22 needs spending authority for the difference in the amount of \$108,000; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
25 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
