1 **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

6 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the
7 County has applied to receive funds from the U.S. Department of Energy that are
8 allocated by formula through the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant; and

10 **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used for such energy conservation measures
11 including, without limitation, the purchase of and installation of lighting at County parks,
12 the purchase of certain electric and hybrid vehicles, the purchase of certain forced draft
13 heaters to be installed at the County landfill, the purchase of and installation of energy
14 efficiency sub-meters to monitor County energy usage, providing home-energy audits to
15 residents; and paying the costs of an energy management consultant; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
18 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
