1 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has requested a transfer of appropriations in
2 the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for Fiscal 2010 transferring \$400,000
3 in bond funding to capital project N3105, Meadowbrook Park, from N3960, Robinson
4 Property Nature Center; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Section 609(b) of the Howard County Charter authorizes and
7 empowers the Howard County Council to make such transfers; and

9 **WHEREAS**, because of certain change orders, the purchase of certain items that
10 were originally budgeted had to be delayed in order to address the change orders and
11 additional funds are needed to address those previously budgeted items; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
14 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.

16 *Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that,*
17 *subject to the provisions of Maryland law, the Howard County Charter, and the Howard*
18 *County Code relating to the budgetary and fiscal procedures, the amount hereafter*
19 *specified is hereby approved, appropriated, and authorized to be disbursed for the*
20 *general County purposes specified and in sums itemized for the fiscal year beginning July*
21 *1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010, as hereinafter indicated:*
