Biography

As a fourth generation farmer on my family farm in Howard County, I have expanded our operation into a profitable and sustainable farm enterprise. Love Dove Farms was established in 2010 after I completed an internship with another certified organic farm, and came to the realization that this is what I was destined to do. Starting with just one acre of vegetables, we have expanded over the past 5 years to 10 acres, nearly doubling every year. We have constantly invested back into our farm and the infrastructure, building 5 high tunnels, installing irrigation, building a walk in cooler, and installing over 2700 feet of Deer fence. We sell at 2 farmers markets in the county, and 1 in Silver Spring. We also operate a 50 member CSA, and work with restaurants in the county. We continue to expand to and grow our operation, focusing on profit and sustainability for our farm.
