I had a conversation today with Ginny Thomas and Bill McCormack. They were exited about the prospect of moving ahead with the Reinventing OM plan. Please read through this email. To reinvent Oakland Mills, it's critical to find something that makes our Village Center a destination. Along with an improved Bridge Columbia, this is what it will take to get developers to invest in midand up-market housing in the Village Center area,

The Village Center Plan floats several possibilities such as an enhanced hockey rink, a 50-meter pool, an indoor track, or a sports medicine/rehab complex. All great ideas, but the Board needs professional advice from economic development experts.

County Executive Allan Kittleman recently agreed to propose \$50,000 for a feasibility study to identify what attraction would work best in Oakland Mills. For its part, the Columbia Association will contribute \$25,000 from this year's budget, meaning that the study could proceed right away!

This is great news for Oakland Mills! It would take our reinvention out of the realm of hopes and dreams and move it much closer to the realm of reality.

But the Village Board needs your help. On October 19, the County Council will hold hearings on the budget that includes \$50,000 toward the Oakland Mills Feasibility Study. Some Council Members may not favor spending the money to help redevelop Oakland Mills.

Please send an email or letter to the County Council before October 19 (one or two sentences are all it takes) asking to keep \$50,000 in the budget for a Feasibility Study for redeveloping the Oakland Mills Village Center.
