1           **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and  
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the  
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

12           **WHEREAS**, grant funds will be used to purchase three buses and to implement a  
13 real-time rideshare program app; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
16 transferred from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve is not encumbered and is  
17 available for transfer.


