A RESOLUTION ratifying the conveyance of 0.157 of an acre of real property in Clarksville by the County to the State Highway Administration.

WHEREAS. Howard County conveyed 0.157 of an acre of real property to the State of Maryland, for use by the State Highway Administration, by Deed of Donation dated November 20, 2014, and recorded among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland in Liber 15889, folio 246 on or about November 21, 2014 ("the SHA Conveyance"); and WHEREAS, the property that was transferred in the SHA Conveyance was part of an approximately 7.768-acre real property in Clarksville ("the Gateway Property") that was the subject of Council Resolution No. 111-2008, approved on November 3, 2008, with the Resolution, based on Howard County Code Section 4.201, authorizing "sale" by the County Executive of the Gateway Property for the purpose of the redevelopment of the Gateway Property; and WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the contract of sale for the 7.761 acres of real property to Greenstone Ventures II, LLC, dated November 27, 2013, obligated the County to "convey" the 0.157 of an acre to the State Highway Administration (i.e., the SHA Conveyance); and WHEREAS, the Office of Law advised that the authorization for "sale" in Resolution No. 111-2008 constituted the necessary legal authority for the SHA Conveyance, for which the County received no State funds, because under Maryland law the sale of real property can occur in exchange for non-monetary consideration, as was the case for the SHA Conveyance; and

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WHEREAS, while recognizing the Office of Law's advice in this matter, the County Council nevertheless wishes to ratify the conveyance of the real property that was the subject of the SHA Conveyance based on both historical practice and, more importantly, Howard County Code Section 4.201(b), that delineates between conveyance and selling of property.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, this day of _______, 2015 that in line with the intent of Howard County Code Section 4.201(b) that the County Council hereby ratifies the County's conveyance, for non-monetary consideration, of 0.157 of an acre of real property to the State of Maryland, for use by the State Highway Administration, by Deed of Donation dated November 20, 2014, and recorded among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland in Liber 15889, folio 246 on or about November 21, 2014.
