1 WHEREAS, Section 4.129(d) of the Howard County Code authorizes the County 2 Purchasing Agent, with the approval of the County Executive and the County Council, to sell or 3 lease surplus supplies to the State or any political subdivision or agency of the State, or to the 4 Federal Government upon such terms and conditions as the County Purchasing Agent deems 5 proper; and

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WHEREAS, in 2011, the County and the National Security Agency ("NSA") agreed the
County would construct a reclaimed water delivery system to NSA's Fort Meade campus (the
"Federal Contract"); and

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11 WHEREAS, the County established and completed capital project W-8323 for the 12 construction of the delivery system and, pursuant to the Federal Contract, was reimbursed for the 13 construction costs by the federal government; and

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WHEREAS, under the capital project, the County installed 8,000 linear feet of 20 inch ductile iron water pipe plus associated valves and ancillary appurtenances, one above ground storage tank (1,000,000 gallons), an altitude/check valve system, a re-chlorination system, and controls (the "Utilities Infrastructure"); and

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the Federal Contract, the delivery system within the boundary of the National Security Agency is to be transferred to the federal contractor which maintains all of the infrastructure within Fort Meade (and other bases in the U.S.A.); and

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WHEREAS, the federal contractor is American Water Operations and Maintenance, Inc.,
a corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas ("American
Water Operations"); and

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WHEREAS, the County Executive has approved the sale of the Utilities Infrastructure to
 American Water Operations upon such terms and conditions as the County Purchasing Agent
 deems proper.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Howard County,
 Maryland this <u>The</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2015 that it approves the sale of the Utilities
 Infrastructure to American Water Operations upon such terms and conditions as the County
 Purchasing Agent deems proper.
