1           **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and  
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the  
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;  
4 and

6           **WHEREAS**, the Department of Corrections has been awarded grant funding in  
7 the amount of \$93,402 from the U.S. Department of Justice for the State Criminal Alien  
8 Assistance Program (SCAAP); and

9  
10           **WHEREAS**, under the SCAAP, the Department of Corrections will receive  
11 federal assistance to offset some of the costs incurred by the County to incarcerate  
12 undocumented individuals who have been convicted of a felony; and

14           **WHEREAS**, while the total amount of the grant is \$93,402, the Department of  
15 Corrections included \$40,000 in their FY 2012 budget in anticipation of this grant and,  
16 therefore, only the balance of \$53,402 needs to be transferred from the Grants Fund,  
17 Contingency Reserve; and

19           **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
20 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
