11	pay scale for the members of Howard county Local 1810 of the American Federation of State,		
12	Local and Municipal Employees ("Local 1810"); and

14	WHEREAS, the Pay Plan is amended to reflect the additional steps (steps 18 and 19) for		
15	Local 1810.

20	Scale for Local 1810 is amended as shown in the attached.

23	that the Act shall apply beginning with the first pay date after July 1, 2015.

25	Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland,		
26	that this Act shall become effective 61 days after enactment.
