The Department of Corrections has been awarded grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). This program provides Federal assistance to states and localities that are incurring costs of incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens who have been convicted of a felony and as such these funds may be used for correctional purposes only. The total award for fiscal year 2012 is \$93,402. The department's FY 2012 budget includes \$40,000 in the grant account for this award.
