1	WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Howard County, Maryland is the fee simple
2	owner of Parcel 'G' as set out and shown on the plats entitled "Oxford Square 'Green
3	Neighborhood' Resubdivision Plat - Parcels 'C' Thru 'L' And Open Space Lots 1 And 2 (A
4	Resubdivision of Parcel 'A', As Shown On Plats Entitled "Oxford Square, Parcels 'A' And 'B'"
5	And Recorded Among The Land Records Of Howard County, Maryland As Plat Nos. 21757
6	Thru 21761)" which plats are recorded among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland
7	on Plat WAR Nos. 22390 thru 22395 (the "Plats") by virtue of the deed from Kellogg-CCP,
8	LLC, dated October 30, 2013 and recorded among the Land Records of Howard County,
9	Maryland in Liber WAR No. 15373, folio 416 (the "Board Property"); and
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11	WHEREAS, Kellogg-CCP, LLC ("Kellogg") is the fee simple owner of Open Space Lot
12	1, as set out and shown on the Plats by virtue of the deed from Oxford Square Master

1, as set out and shown on the Plats by virtue of the deed from Oxford Square Master Association, Inc. dated March 7, 2014 and recorded among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland in Liber WAR No. 15496, folio 326 (the "Kellogg Property"); and

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WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a land swap for the purpose of enhancing the value and use of their respective parcels; and

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WHEREAS, the acreage of the Kellogg Property to be conveyed to the Board is the same acreage as the Board Property to be conveyed to Kellogg, as shown in the attached Exhibit A and Exhibit B; and

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WHEREAS, Section 4.203 of the Howard County Code provides that when the Board of Education determines that real property of the Board is no longer needed for educational purposes, but that other property is available which is needed for educational purposes and that the owner is willing to convey the other property to the County for the Board of Education in exchange for the school property, then the parties may exchange the property after the Board of Education has received approval of the property exchange from the State Superintendent of Schools, the interagency committee for school construction (IAC) and any other State agencies which must consent to the property transfer; and

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1	WHEREAS, Section 4.203 further provides that the property transfer may take place
2	provided that the County Executive agrees to the proposed transfer and the County Council
3	approves the transfer by resolution; and
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5	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 4-115 of the Education Article of the Annotated
6	Code of Maryland, any real property no longer needed for school purposes must be transferred
7	back from the local Board of Education to the County in which the property lies; and
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9	WHEREAS, the County Executive's signature on this Resolution indicates that he agrees
10	to the proposed transfer.
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12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County
13	Maryland, this day of, 2016, that it approves the proposed
14	exchange of approximately 0.737 acres of land owned by the Board of Education with the same
15	amount of land owned by Kellogg, as shown in the attached Exhibit A and Exhibit B.
