7 **SUBTITLE 9. COMPUTATION OF TIME.**

8
9 **SECTION 22.900. DEFINITIONS.**

10 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:

11 (A) *DEADLINE* MEANS THE LAST DAY OF ANY PERIOD OF TIME BY WHICH ANY PERSON OR COUNTY
12 DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY IS REQUIRED TO TAKE SOME ACTION.

13 (B) *HOLIDAY* MEANS RECOGNIZED COUNTY, STATE, AND FEDERAL HOLIDAYS.

14 (C) *ORDINARY BUSINESS HOURS* MEANS 8 A.M. TO 5 P.M. ON MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.

16 **SECTION 22.901. APPLICATION.**

17 THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO ANY DEADLINE ESTABLISHED BY THIS CODE.

19 **SECTION 22.902. COMPUTATION OF TIME.**

20 (A) *BEGINNING OF THE PERIOD OF TIME*. IN COMPUTING ANY PERIOD OF TIME PRESCRIBED BY THIS
21 CODE, THE DAY OF THE ACT, EVENT, OR DEFAULT, AFTER WHICH THE DESIGNATED PERIOD OF TIME
22 BEGINS TO RUN, IS NOT TO BE INCLUDED.

23 (B) *DEADLINE*. THE DEADLINE IS TO BE COMPUTED AS FOLLOWS:

24 (1) IF THE LAST DAY IS A SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR HOLIDAY, THE DEADLINE SHALL BE
25 THE END OF THE NEXT DAY, WHICH IS NOT A SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR HOLIDAY; OR

26 (2) IF THE COUNTY OFFICE IS NOT OPEN ON THE LAST DAY OF THE PERIOD, OR IS CLOSED
27 FOR A PART OF A DAY, THE DEADLINE SHALL BE THE END OF THE NEXT DAY WHICH
28 IS:

29 (I) NOT A SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR HOLIDAY; OR

30 (II) A DAY ON WHICH THE COUNTY OFFICE IS OPEN THE ENTIRE DAY DURING
