6	Capital Budget for FY2017, while the County Executive's Proposed Budget included	
7	\$70,050,000, leaving a \$34,961,000 shortfall; and

9	WHEREAS, throughout the County Council's budget deliberations, the County	
10	Executive and his budget office assured the Council repeatedly that his proposed budget fully	
11	funded the needs of the school system, including its negotiated agreements with educators; and

13	WHEREAS, the Board and its staff have insisted stated that the proposed budget, which	
14	was ultimately adopted by the Council, will would necessitate drastic cuts; and
