And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that, to establish the stagger of terms required by § 6.300 of the Howard County Code, of the initial appointees to the Commission, 23 appointees shall have a term of 1 year, 23 appointees shall have a term of 2 years, 3 appointees shall have a term of 34 years, 3 appointees shall have a term of 4 years, and 34 appointees shall have a term of 5 years, as provided in the Resolutions that confirm the appointments.
