Advisory Board Members Present: Chair David Salem, Vice Chair Mitch Stahm, Vernon Curry, Dennis Raschka, and Katy Sedney.

Staff Present: Kelly Madigan, Inspector General; Amanda Mihill, Senior Assistant County Solicitor; Nicholas Rinehart, Senior Legislative Analyst; and Isaiah Anderson, Executive Assistant I, were present.

Chair Salem opened the meeting at 6:30pm.

Inspector General Update – Presentation and Discussion

Kelly Madigan, Inspector General of Howard County, appeared before the Board to give an update on her first eight weeks as the Inspector General. Highlights of Ms. Madigan's accomplishments in the first eight weeks included the following:

- Drafted new policies and procedures
- Created an OIG website and an official OIG seal.
- The OIG has received 13 complaints so far, including allegations of misconduct and fraud.
- In the process of developing a case management system, and annual training course for Howard County employees about the OIG's functions.

Ms. Madigan also gave an update about legislation at the state level that is under consideration by the Maryland General Assembly regarding access to information for local Inspectors General.

There was general discussion amongst Board members regarding more details about the state legislation, finalizing the office space for the Office of Inspector General, and the proposed OIG training for Howard County employees.

Other Business

Chair Salem opened the floor for any additional discussion topics from Board members. There was a brief discussion confirming that future Inspector General Advisory Board meetings will continue to be hybrid meetings.

There were no additional topics proposed for discussion.

Chair Salem announced that the next Inspector General Advisory Board meeting would be conducted on Thursday, June 4, 2026.
