- 1. **Council Resolution 35-2017** Introduced by the Chairperson at the request of Meadowlark, LLC A RESOLUTION to close a portion of Forest Avenue, as shown in Exhibits A and B, in accordance with Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code.
- 2. **Council Bill 31-2017** (ZRA 171) Introduced by the Chairperson at the request of Olenka Stasyshyn AN ACT amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations Conditional Use section to add a new Instructional School use to the R-20 Zoning District; and generally relating to Instructional Schools.
- 3. Council Bill 30-2017 Introduced by Jennifer Terrasa and Jon Weinstein AN ACT establishing a voluntary Citizens' Election Fund system for candidates for County Executive or County Council; regulating specified campaign finance activities of a candidate who accepts public funding; providing for the administration and enforcement of specified aspects of the Citizens' Election Fund system; providing certain penalties for violations of the Citizens' Election Fund system; creating a Citizens' Election Fund Commission and specifying its composition and duties; requiring the Director of Finance to take specified actions; and generally related to elections for County offices.

The public is invited to give testimony at the public hearing or to send written testimony any time before the final vote.
